Time Frame and Data Sources

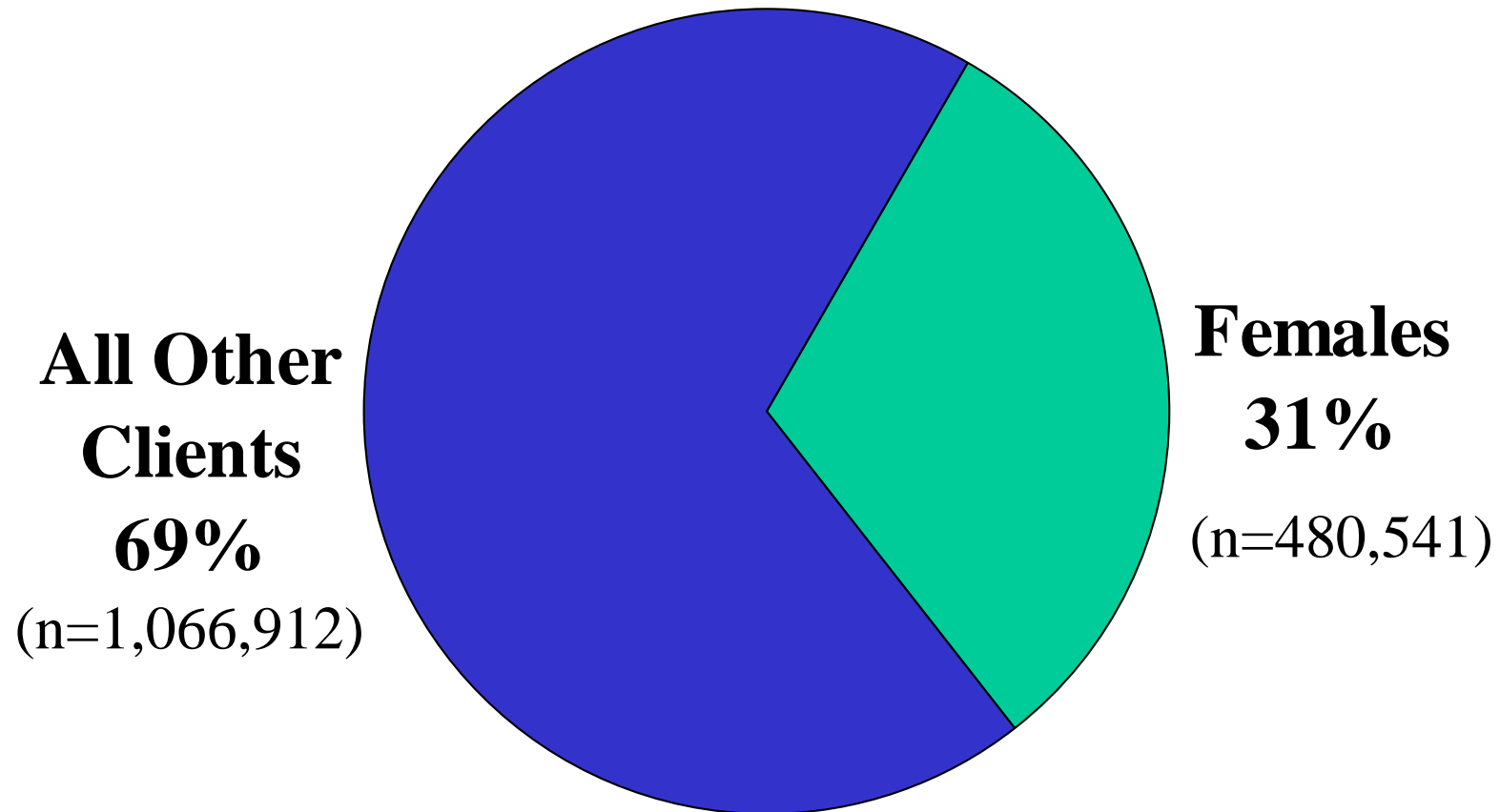
- July 2003 through June 2005
 - (2-year period)
- Evaluating Local Interventions (ELI)
 - Education & Prevention Activities
 - NIGHT Outreach
- HIV Counseling and Testing (C&T)
- Prevention SOWs for funding

Limitations

- C&T:
 - Due to data system changes and compatibility issues, no Los Angeles County data was included for July 2004-June 2005
- ELI:
 - Majority of contacts from Outreach Checksheets
 - Extremely limited summary information
 - Cannot look at race by risk information together
 - Budget information estimated
 - Target groups are not mutually exclusive
 - LHJ decides which target to select
 - Limited data from Los Angeles County in ELI

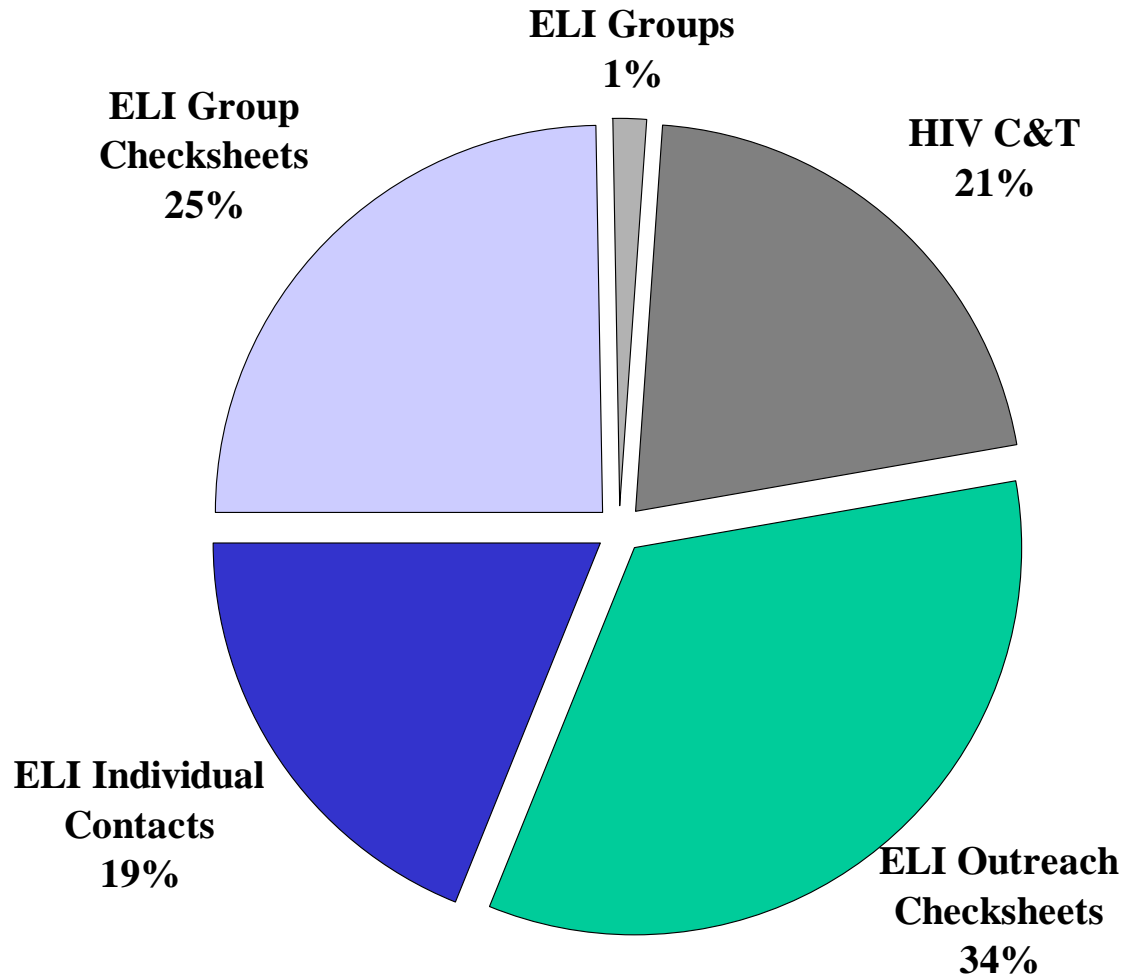
Number and Percent of Female Clients in HIV Prevention Services

FY 2003/04 and 2004/05



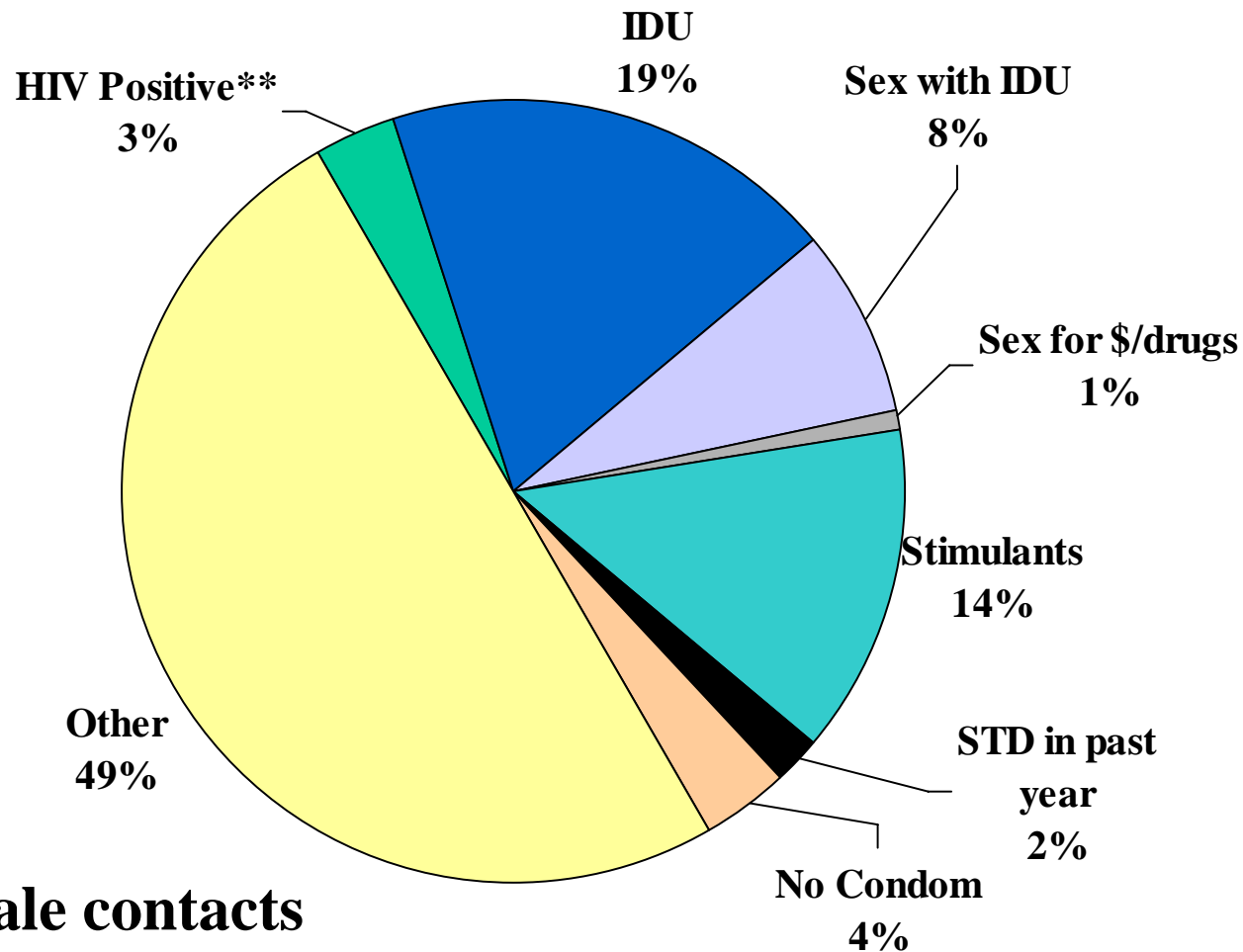

Females by Intervention/Form Type

- 59% of contacts are obtained by outreach and group checksheet forms
- 19% ELI individual contacts include:
 - Outreach encounters greater than 5 minutes
 - Prevention case management
 - Various individual level interventions
- 21% of contacts through HIV C&T

**Includes repeat clients

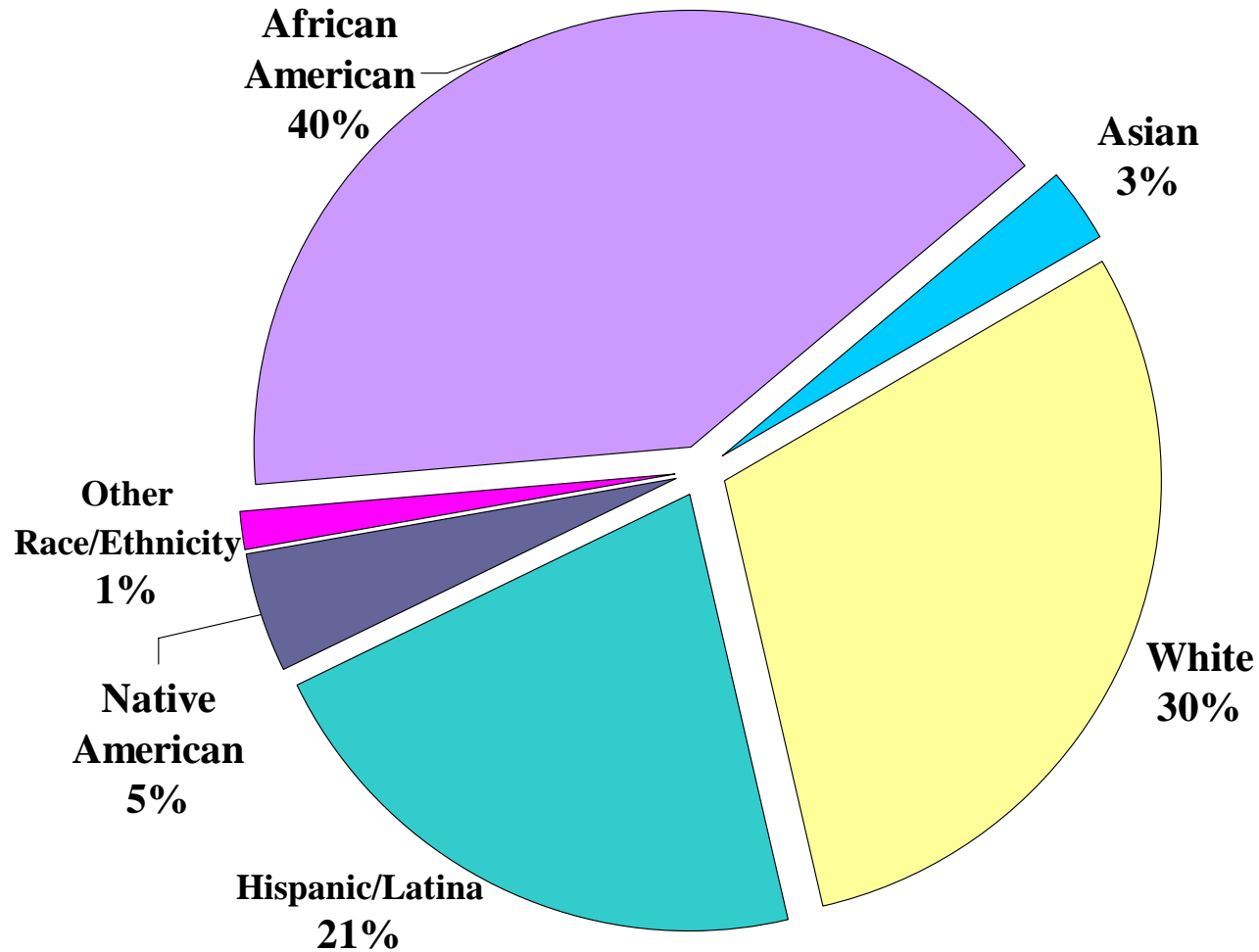

ELI: Females by Risk

- 3% of female contacts HIV positive
 - Includes repeat clients
 - Seen in more intensive interventions
- 41% associated with either using injection drugs, stimulant drugs or having sex with an IDU
- Nearly 50% have low or unknown risk
- ELI forms do not collect whether partner of client is HIV+
 - Should be added at next update

FY 2003/04 and 2004/05

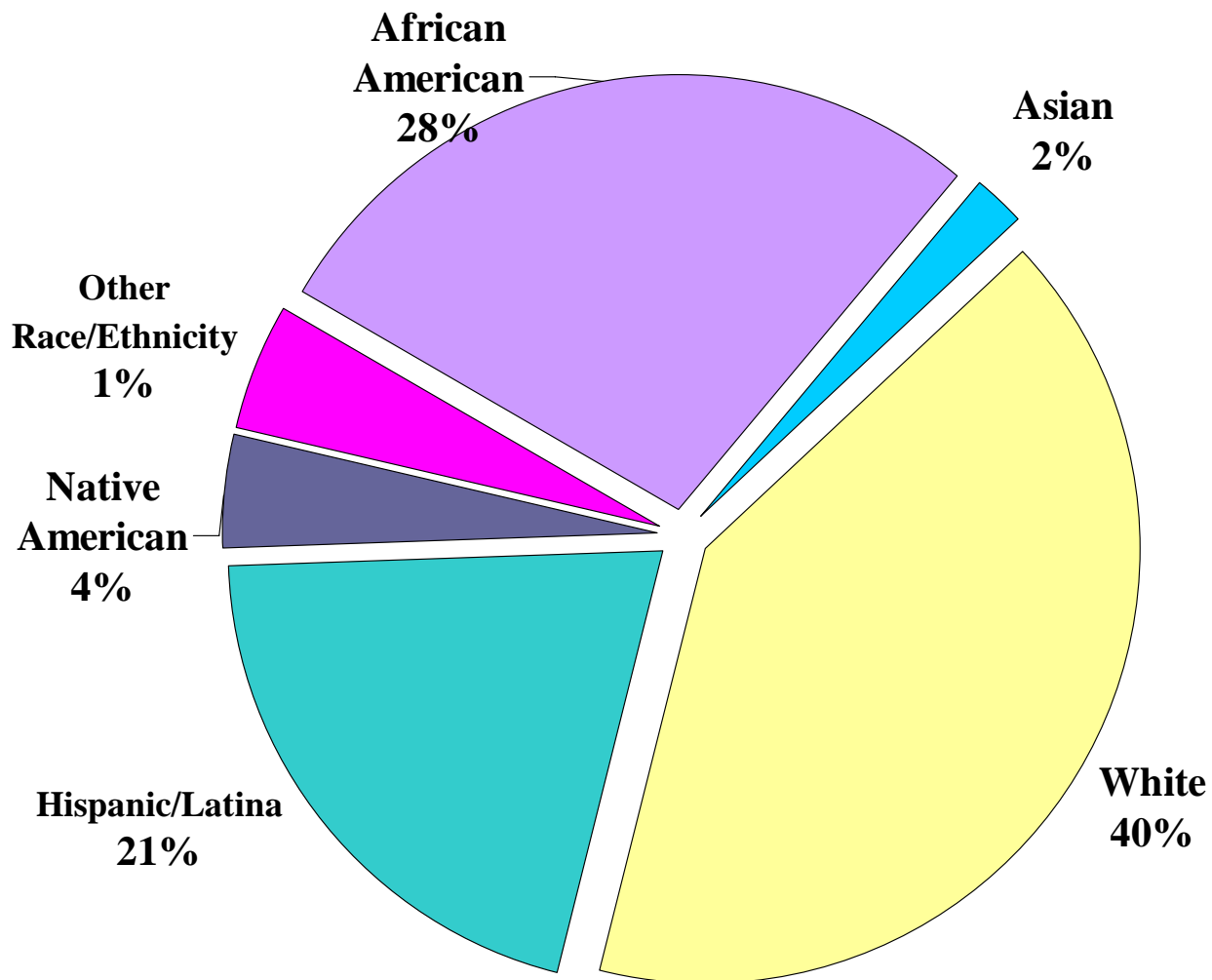

FY 2003/04 and 2004/05

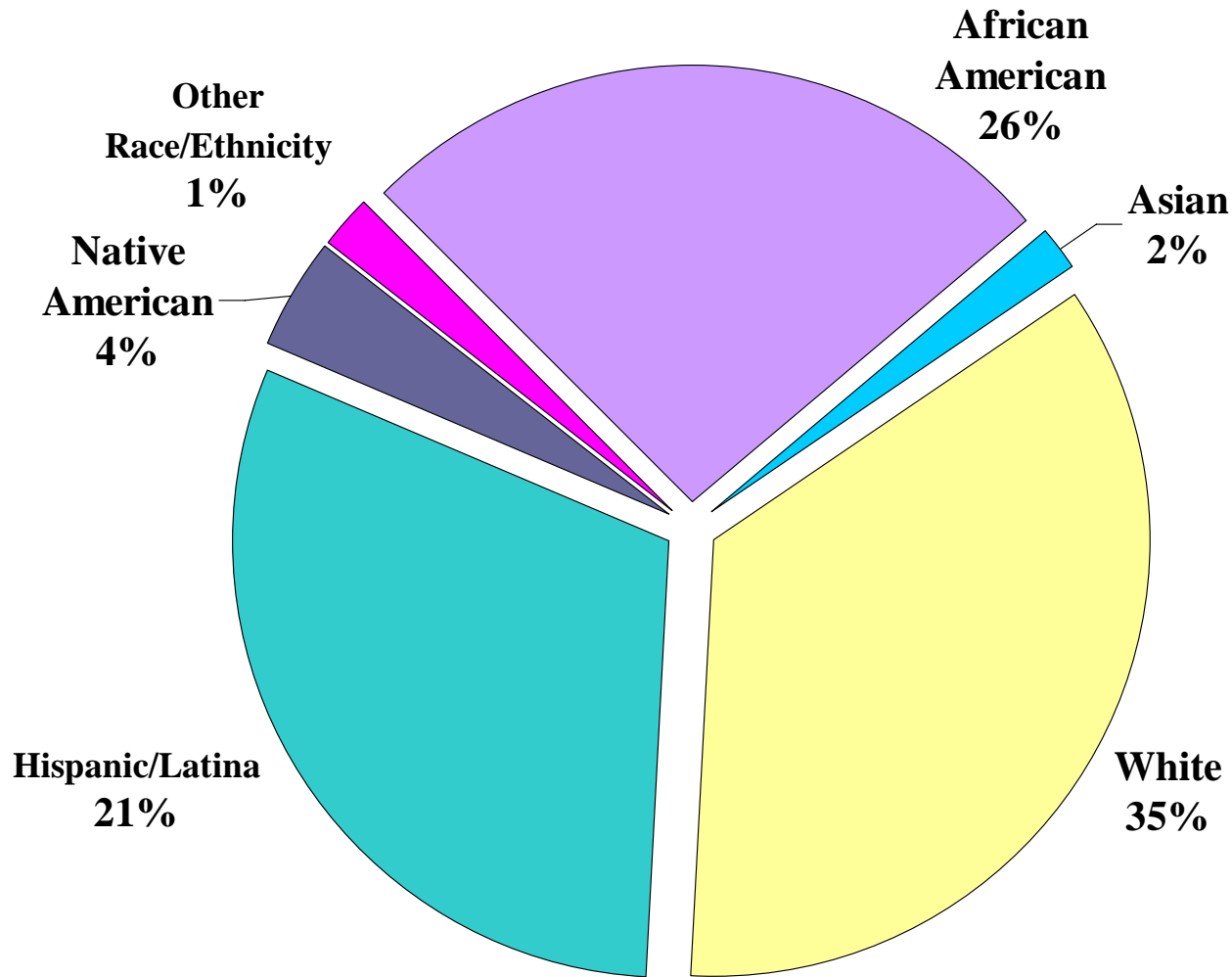

FY 2003/04 and 2004/05

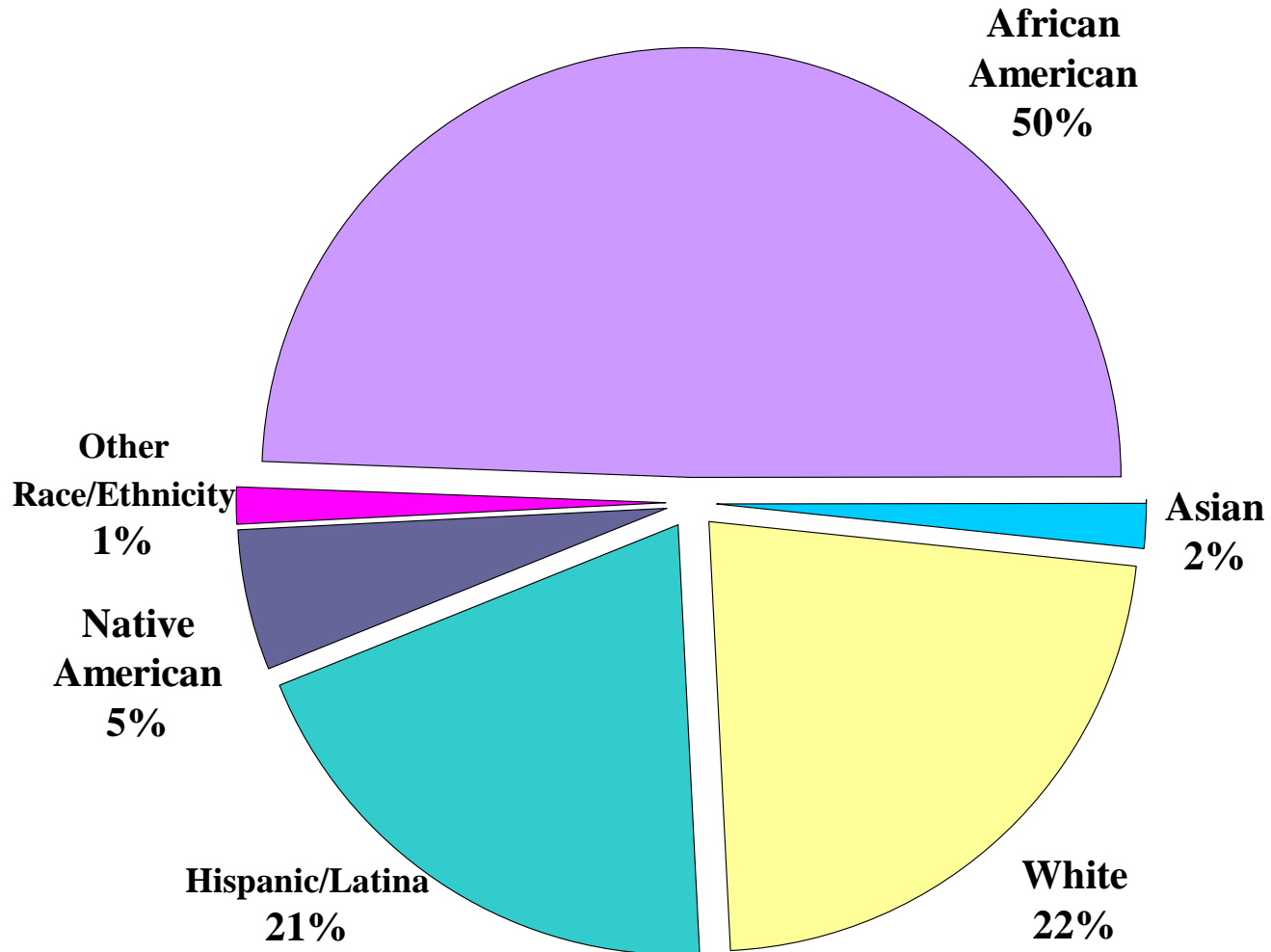

777 female contacts

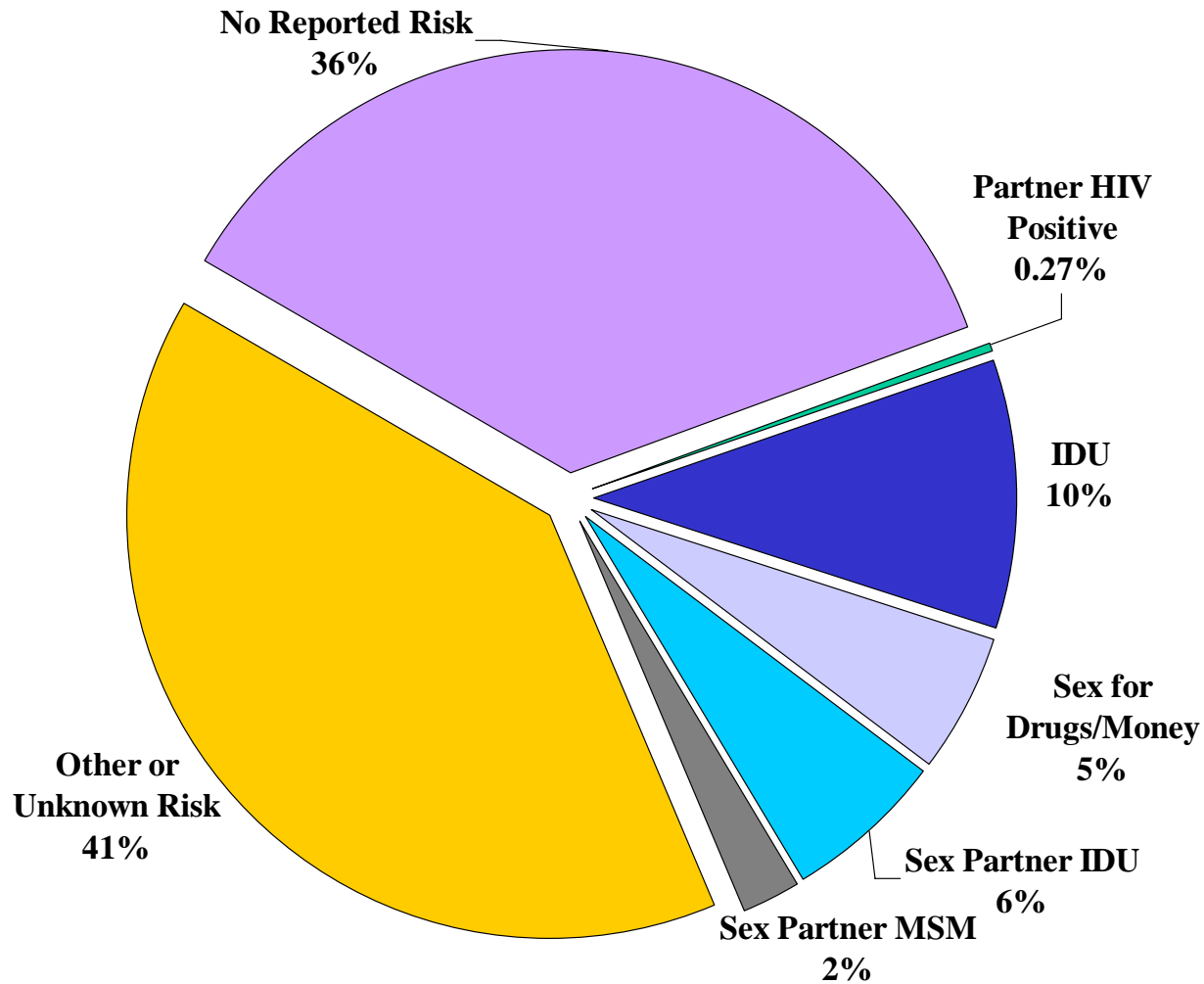

ELI Individual Contact Interventions: Females by Race and Risk

- AA females disproportionately represented
 - 40% of HIV positive females
 - 50% of females reporting sex for drugs/money
- Latinas were consistently represented throughout the risks at 21%
- White females reported high rate of injection drug use compared to other risks
- Native American representation is relatively high among females
 - 4-5% in ELI compared with 1-2% in C&T

HIV C&T: Females by Risk

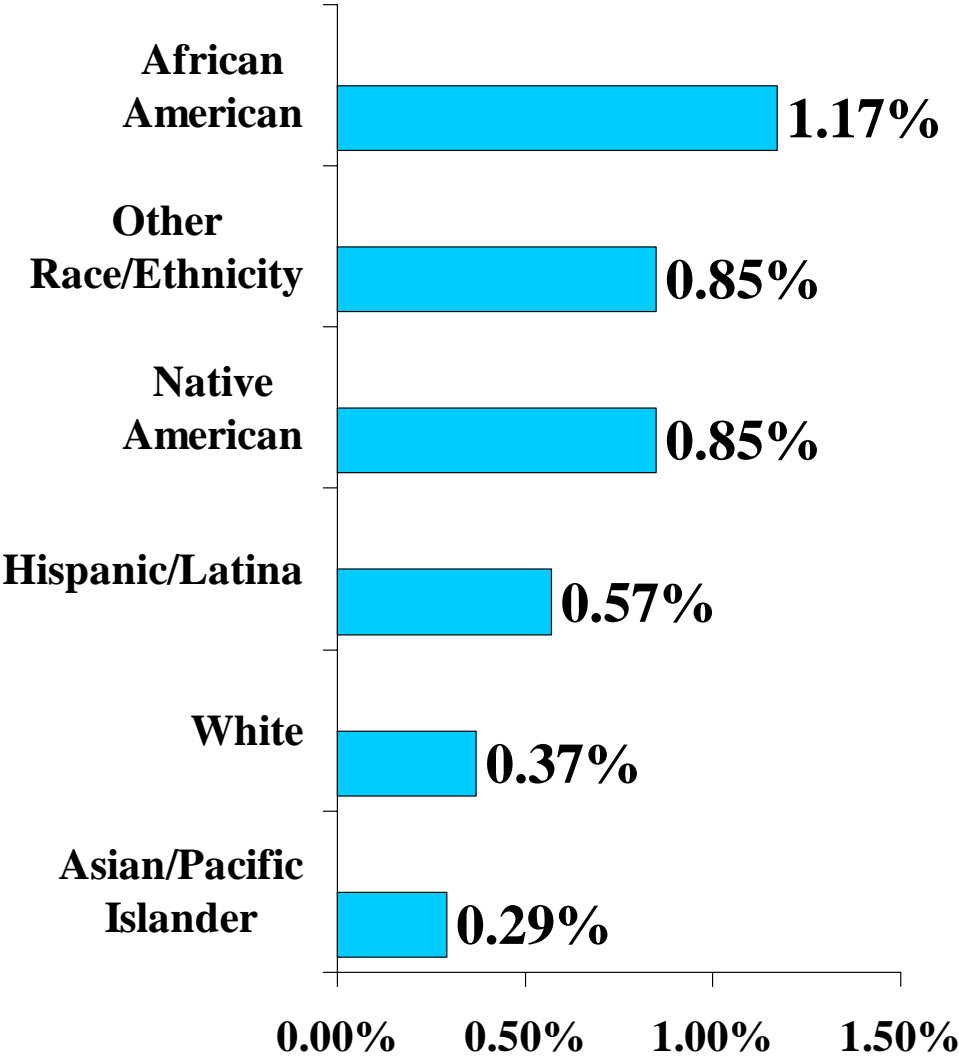

HIV C&T: Percentage of HIV Positive Females by Race/Ethnicity

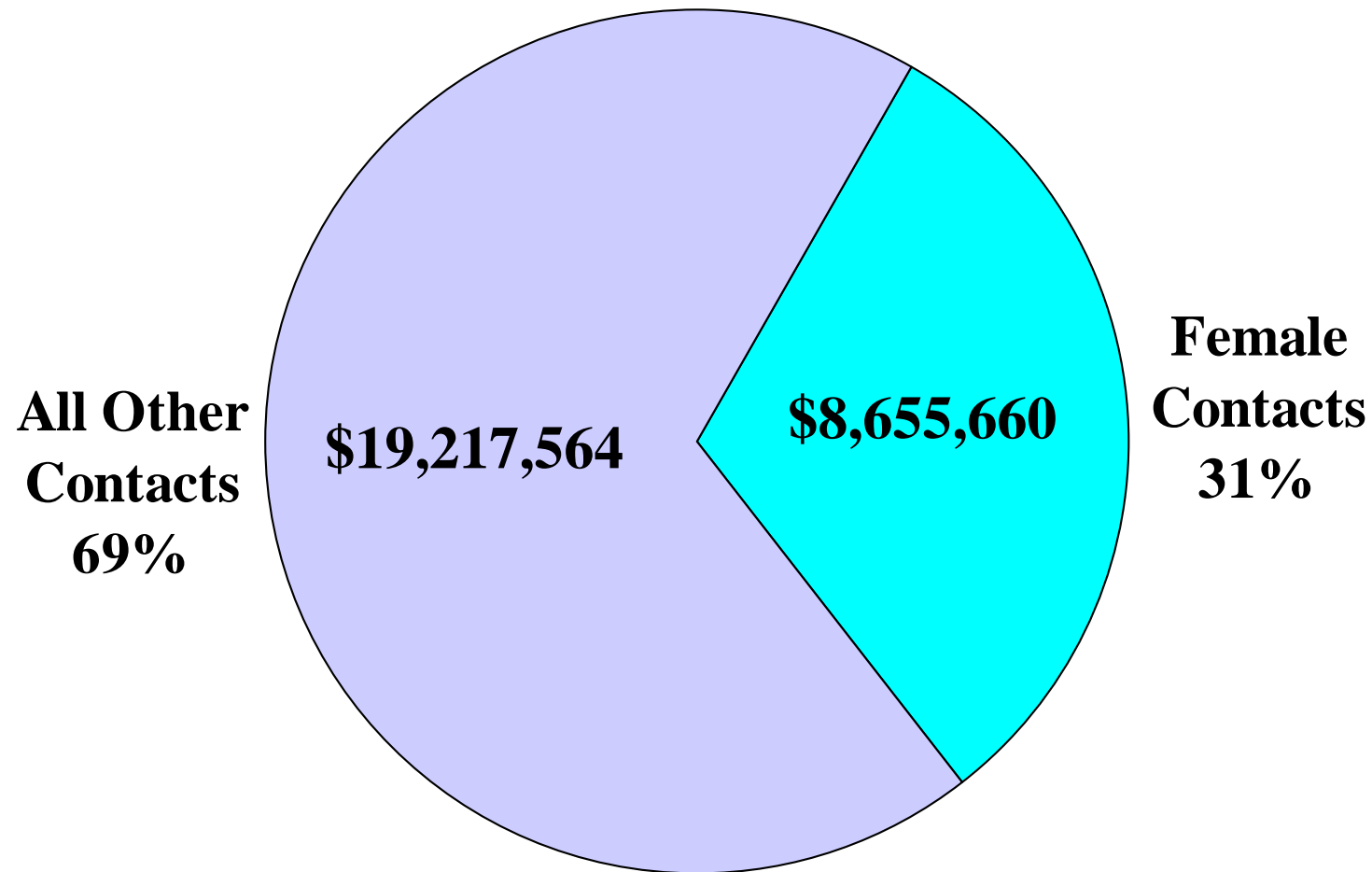

HIV C&T: Females by Risk

- 77% of females testing at C&T sites had unknown or low risk
- AA females have highest percent of HIV positive tests (1.17%)
- IDU most common risk among females
- 2,688 females reported having sex with an HIV-positive partner

TOTAL=\$27,873,223

Average Annual Estimate of Prevention Funds for Females

- \$8.65 million estimated for female services
 - 26% of these dollars for HIV C&T
 - 74% of these dollars for E&P and NIGHT outreach
- Annual estimate based on the average of FY 2003/04 and FY 2004/05
- Refer to limitations of the data at beginning of presentation
