Horton	<p>Would revise the list of reportable diseases and conditions by requiring the department to specify the timeliness requirements related to the reporting of each disease and condition, and the mechanisms required for, and the content to be included in, reports made pursuant to these provisions. Would require by July 1, 2009, or within one year of the establishment of a state laboratory reporting system, whichever is later, any laboratory that generates a report pursuant to these provisions to submit that report electronically in a manner specified by the department. Kuehl	Would require each clinical lab to report all CD4 count test results, as defined, to the local health officer within 7 days of the completion of the CD4 count test. If a CD4 count test result is related to a case of HIV infection, the local health officer would be required to report the case of HIV infection or AIDS to the department within 45 days of receipt of the report. Would require DHCS, by Mar 1, 2009, to complete an implementation plan containing specified elements and prepared in consultation with a local stateholder advisory committee, which this bill require the dept. to convene in accordance with specified criteria, and to take certain actions relating to the development of the pilot program.
